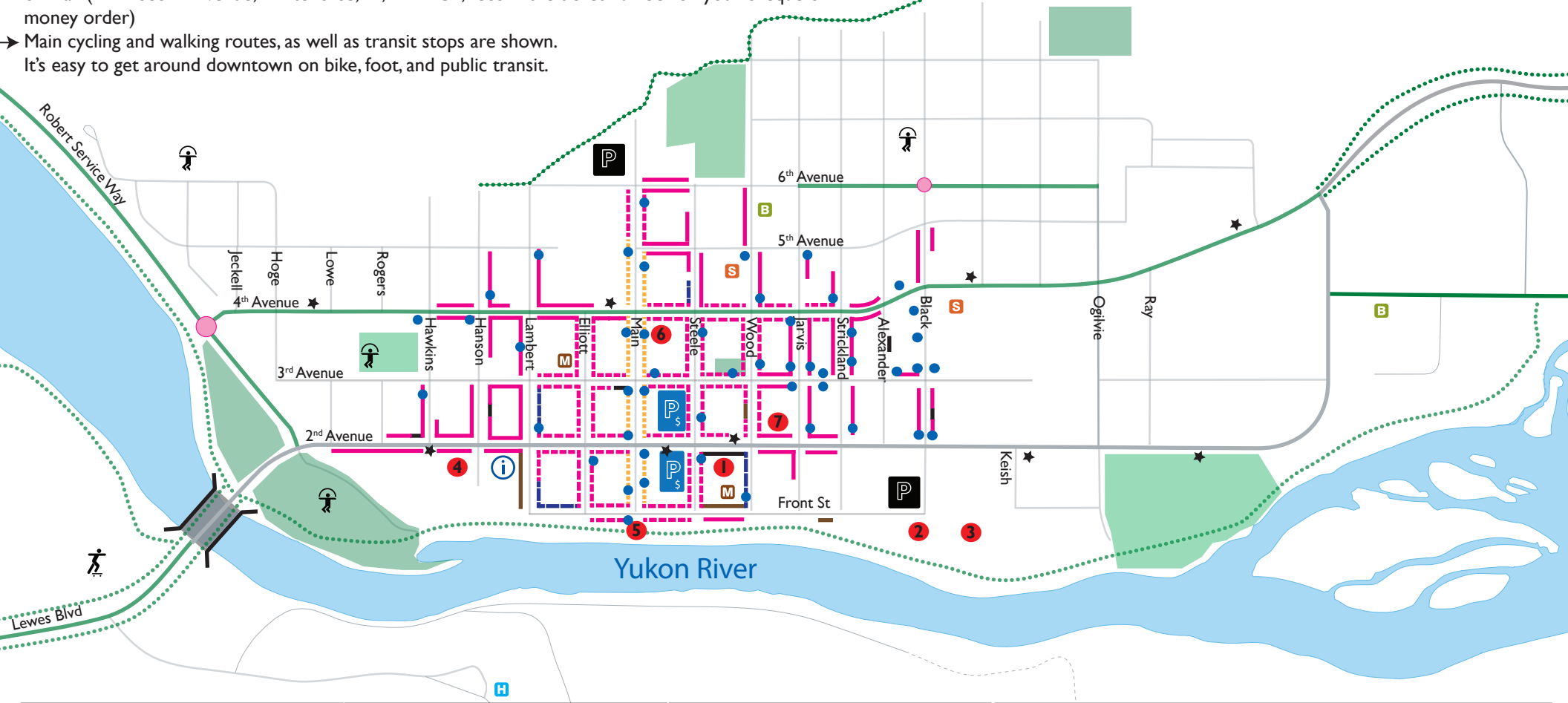
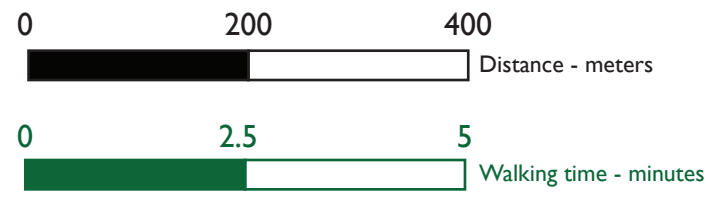


Downtown Whitehorse Parking and Transportation Map

- This map is only for reference to locate on and off-street public parking zones in the downtown area. Parking designations are subject to change. **Always obey posted signage.**
- All alleys are strictly no-parking at any time - even in the absence of signs.
- Parking tickets can be paid in person at City Hall (08:30-16:30), by phone 667-6401 (Visa and Mastercard) or mail (2121 Secind Avenue, Whitehorse, YT, Y1A 1C2; record the ticket number on your cheque or money order)
- Main cycling and walking routes, as well as transit stops are shown. It's easy to get around downtown on bike, foot, and public transit.
